2. Ted Brito reported that National sanction has been received for our Fall Float Fly on October 20<sup>th</sup>. It was unanimously voted to reimburse Contest Director Ned Watts \$20 for the event application.
3. The New Bedford Boys and Girls Club field event is scheduled for Saturday June 16<sup>th</sup>. Representatives from Horizon Hobby and the AMA will attend. Rules and protocol will be discussed first and flying will take place between 12 noon and 3 p.m.
4. Our annual Fun Fly is scheduled for July 14<sup>th</sup>. The Brito's have already purchased some soft drinks. Food will be outsourced. It will be an open format for flying with the exception of time slots for combat and helicopters. It was unanimously voted to rename the event the "Dave Andrade Memorial Fun Fly".
5. A lifetime membership plaque was presented to Bud Bier and a round of applause followed.

1. Ted Brito suggested we purchase tractor ramps in order to facilitate cleaning of the deck. It was unanimously voted to authorize the spending of up to \$60 for these items.
