## **Unfinished Business**

- 1- Jeff Rebello could not make the meeting but sent an email explaining the club decals. “The decals are complete (printed 50-just seemed like a nice round number plus it gives us a few extra). Also, as previously discussed, I'll switch up the color schemes so each year will be different and specific to only that year”.

If all is well we will be placing the final order for parts later this week or early next week.
